## (Tour & Track Targa Tasmania) Information Sheet.

### Introduction

Targa Tasmania is an exciting six day, competitive stage, tarmac rally across Tasmania with some of the world's finest cars. The world's best touring, sports and GT cars contend in competitive stages on the island's toughest roads, travelling more than 2000kms to challenge the best in the country. This year will see a record field of more than 350 of the world's finest cars and drivers travel on Tasmania's scenic routes and mountain passes.

### The Targa Tour

Join Driving Events at our 2017 assault in Targa Tasmania where Paul Stokell and Daniel Willson will take on the event in our specially prepared V6 Lotus Exige. Spend your choice of 6, 7 or 10 Days in Tasmania, experiencing spectacular roads, beautiful scenery, the tastes and welcoming atmosphere. The tour is an amazing experience, but not a race. It is designed to display a cavalcade of vehicles, giving owners an opportunity to use them safely, while enjoying the thrill of driving past, literally, thousands of spectators all watching the world's largest tarmac rally.

Normal speed limits apply to the Targa Tour, but Tasmania has some incredible winding mountain passes that most competition cars would struggle to break, leaving plenty of opportunity to enjoy your vehicle in a very "spirited" manner. Our group will consist of between 10 – 15 cars with our nominated Tour Leader taking you through each stage running at the front of the field, meaning some early starts each day, often before 7.00am. Overnight stops and accommodation will mirror the competitors. At the completion of each day there will be an opportunity for service work before relaxing into you're your evening. We have selected quality accommodation and a Targa guide to help make this a stress free and guaranteed fun event..

Along with the tour, a street stage in George Town is a part of Targa that makes it truly unique. The tour covers the entire island, an island varying in landscape from open farm to rugged coastlines and large mountain ranges. You will get to drive on iconic stages including, The Sidling, Cethana, Hellyer Gorge and of course, the 52 km, Mt Arrowsmith.

The event will finish in Hobart with a party atmosphere followed by a day of sight-seeing and the official Targa Dinner and trophy presentation.

### The Track

For those that wish to extend their stay we have booked a Track & Training day at Hobart's "Baskerville Raceway". Baskerville was opened in 1958 and continues to be the longest operating permanent circuit in Australia. It is also one of Australia's most challenging and enjoyable racetracks. Recently resurfaced it is guaranteed to please even the most ardent track driver!

Finally we will travel and overnight on a private beach resort in Bicheno before a leisurely sight-seeing drive back to Devonport to meet the ferry.

### Eligibility

Entry is for 2 people (Driver & Co-driver). Both must have a Level 2 non speed event CAMS licence. Driving suits and FIA apparel are **NOT** mandatory. Helmets must be worn but HANS devices are not compulsory. Cars for the tour do not require any special preparation. Roll cages, special tyres and extensive modifications are not a requirement. They do need to be road registered and have all standard features such as seat belts etc. Fire extinguishers are not compulsory (or though we would recommend carrying one). A first aid kit will be required along with oil spill kits etc. Full requirements can be supplied upon request.

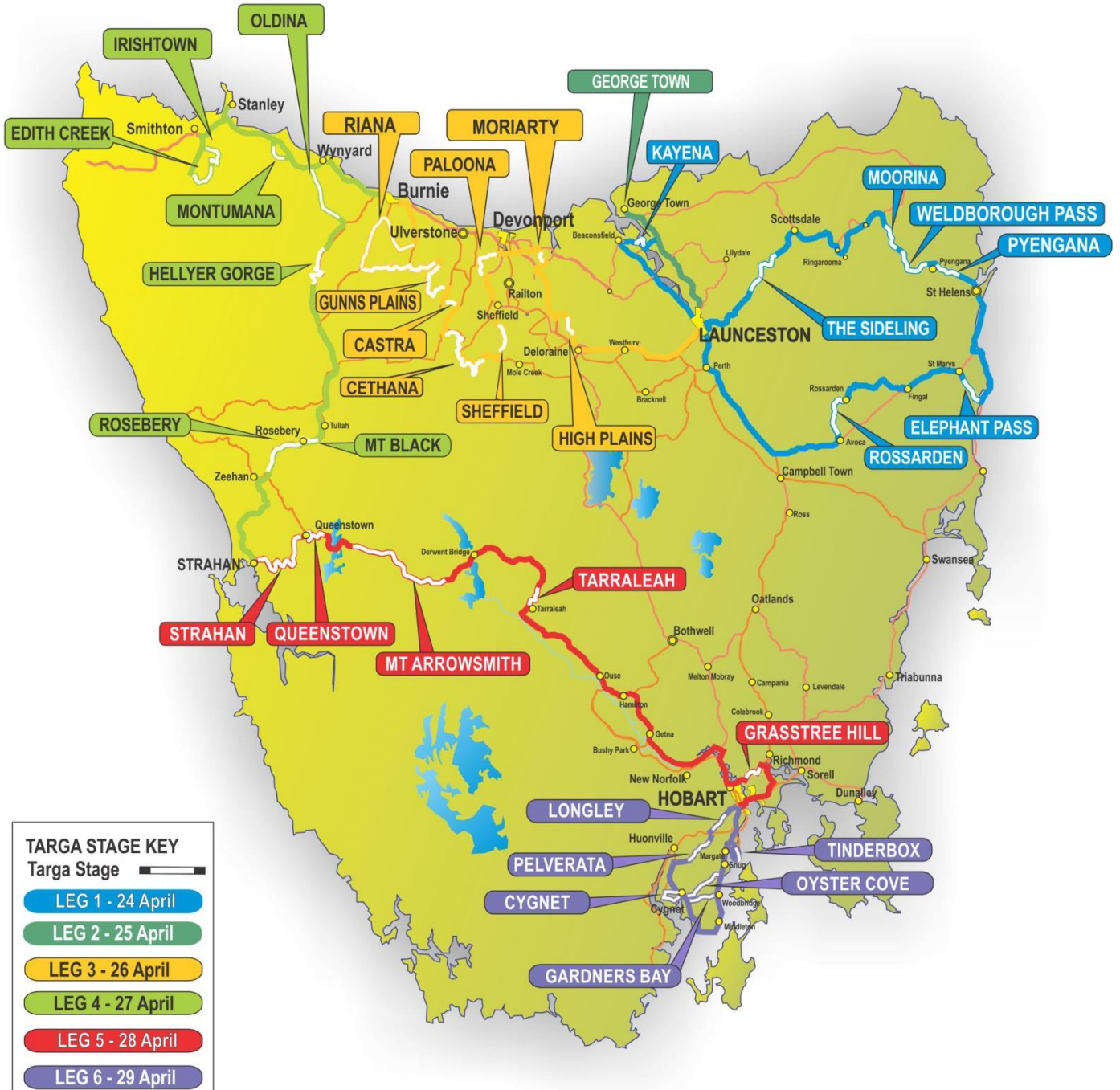
