| Friday 14 November:

Arrive in Melbourne. Derek greets you at the car drop-off, then a convoy to Geelong. Overnight ferry to Devonport in your twin-share cabin. **The vehicle drop-off point** is located approximately 15 minutes from Melbourne's Tullamarine Airport

| Saturday 15 November:

Arrive Devonport and drive to Hobart for pre-event scrutineering.

| Sunday 23 November:

Arrival in Geelong & Vehicle Handover

Upon arrival in Geelong, you'll be notified when it's time to return to the car deck and disembark with your vehicle. If your car is being freighted, **Derek will guide you back to the original vehicle drop-off point**, located approximately 15 minutes from Melbourne's Tullamarine Airport. Final arrangements will be confirmed based on your individual freight plan.
